ICIMOD gathers, generates, and shares knowledge through a variety of innovative means that support all the programmes.

Over the past four years, the programmes have begun to work in a more integrated manner to respond to the complexities of the issues facing this mountainous region. In 2011, ICIMOD launched its first regional programme completely integrating research in the Centre's core areas across geographic landscapes and river basins.
