

Kangchenjunga Landscape Feasibility Assessment Report

This report presents the current socioeconomic and ecological scenario of the landscape. It is based on the individual Feasibility Assessment Reports prepared through a consultative process by the three countries within the landscape: Bhutan, India, and Nepal. This report also highlights the conservation and development priorities within the landscape, many of which can only be addressed through regional cooperation among the three countries.

Kangchenjunga Landscape Conservation and Development Strategy and Regional Cooperation Framework

This framework primarily seeks to strike a balance between the development needs of the resident population and the conservation functions of the landscape. It emphasizes the linking of protected areas through conservation corridors to increase their conservation effectiveness, improvement of local economies based on ecosystem services, enhancing the resilience of local communities to climate and socio-economic change, safeguarding local culture and indigenous knowledge, and promoting the integrated regional approach in management of ecosystems.
