




Context

- Mountain people, particularly women and the poor, are more vulnerable to the risks posed by climate change and other drivers of change.
- Development interventions are dominated by men and often overlook the roles of women in decision making.
- There is the need to support meaningful women's participation and leadership for the sustainability of large cardamom interventions.
- Since 2015, Himalica has provided trainings in large cardamom value chain development to more than 1,500 people, nearly one-third of whom were women farmers.
