The local community in Teru, a settlement in Ghizer District of Gilgit-Baltistan, has developed a participatory pasture management plan for the yak value chain under the Support to Rural Livelihoods and Climate Change Adaptation in the Himalaya (Himalica) initiative. The plan lays out detailed information on grazing capacity, the sustainable use of pasture resources, and the need for fodder production during the lean season.
