5. Ensure universal access to clean energy in the mountains from sources that are affordable, reliable, and sustainable




6 Halt biodiversity loss and land degradation, and sustainably manage forests and ecosystems in the mountains to enhance ecosystem resilience for sustained flow of services




Ensure sustainable adaptation to climate change and disaster risk reduction in the mountains through evidence-based decision making
