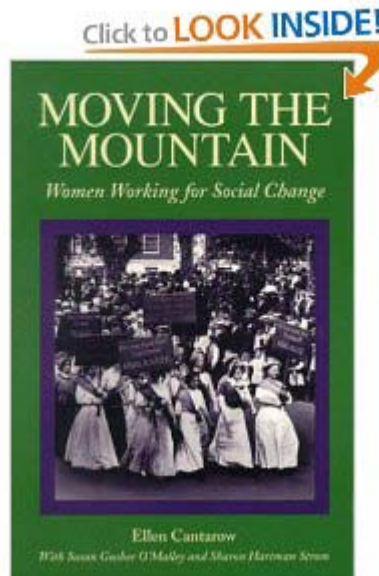


Moving the mountain: Women working for social change

Florence Luscomb campaigned for suffrage early in the century and went to work in the labour, peace, and contemporary women's movement. Ella Baker was a civil rights organiser for over fifty years. Jessie Lopez De La Cruz, a lifelong farmworker, was the first woman to organise in the fields for the United Farmworkers.
