Addressing transboundary conservation and development challenges on the roof of the world

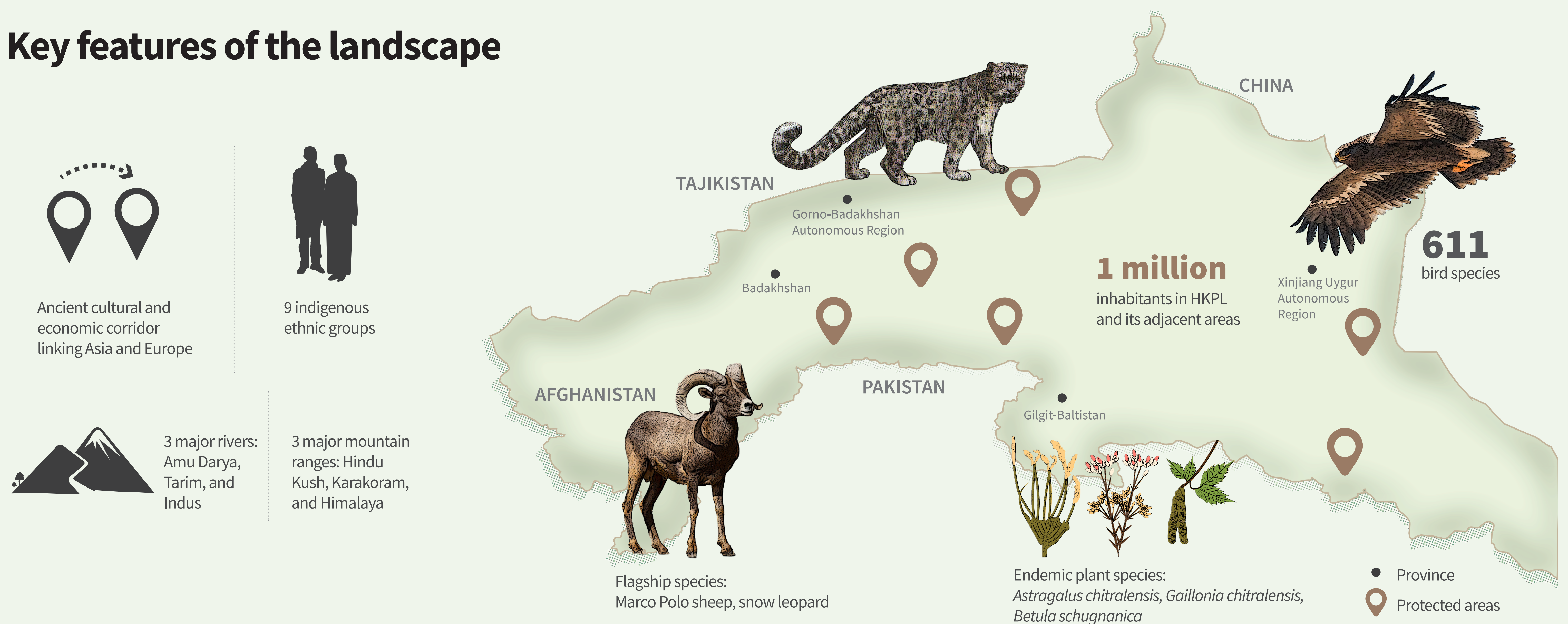
## Our focus
