

Scaling springshed management in Kavre





Springshed management is a Nature-based Solution that responds to gender, equality and social inclusion needs, and is characterised by community involvement and ownership. The scaling out of springshed management is implemented through incremental involvement of and investments from local, provincial and national government and other stakeholders.

The purpose for scaling

Responds to community interest and anxieties over declining spring flows, uncertainties related to water availability for household use and farming, and distress migration – when migration from rural areas is a forced choice, due to a number of factors including the climate crisis, conflicts and a lack of opportunities.
